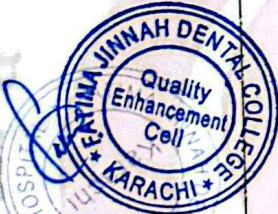

Scholarship policy

QEC/FJDC/POL/8.2

Purpose:

To enable students who have good academic standing and who need financial assistance to continue their medical education with ease. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to deserving students who demonstrate both academic excellence and financial need. The scholarship aims to support students in achieving their educational goals and contributing to the institution's mission.

Description:

Eligibility criteria:

- **Academic Performance:**

- Applicable after 1st year BDS. Student showing excellent performance in Academics are eligible for scholarship.
- Merit based scholarships are provided to limited number of students with exceptional demonstration of academic performance record.

- **Financial Need:**

Student with financial hardships can apply for scholarship on need bases. They must provide evidence of documents as listed below along with formal application to the Chairman/CEO;

- Income of parents/guardians
- Students facing/experiencing unexpected financial hardship

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- Documentation of financial hardships to be provided (e.g. job loss, medical bills, natural calamity etc.)

Scholarship Benefit:

Eligible student will receive a sum on 5% waiver on their tuition fee after completion of 1st year of the academic year of B.D.S. The scholarship is subject to renewal as per discretion of Board of Management/CEO/Chairman.

Types of scholarship:

- Need based
- Merit based

FJDC grants financial assistance on performance and need based scholarship to students for BDS program.

Application Process:

- Students seeking an exception to the policy must submit a formal application with supporting documentation.
- Application forms and deadlines will be clearly communicated.
- The college will review applications confidentially and make a decision within a specified timeframe.

Communication and Resources:

- This policy will be clearly communicated to prospective students via official channel.
- Information on available financial aid options, such as scholarships or student loans (if applicable), shall be discussed with the financial advisor.

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
